## Swirls Lesson 10: Command Cards



- Swirls permits some rfid tags (cards) to be used to instigate commands rather than dancer toggles
  - As an example, the "Present:Roll" command card will toggle the display between Present mode (see tutorial#2 and #7) and Squares mode (see tutorial#2 and #5).
- The z command is used to have Swirls generate command cards
- Type z and then swipe a new card
- A display will be shown (see graphic above) with a number of choices
- Simply click on one of the choices and that card will cause the associated action to occur
- The bright entries have already been assigned to a card
- Summary: z swipe-card select-action

roll:present	this card will toggle between showing the Present Display (Swirls manual Sec. 8)
	and rolling up a new Squares Display (Swirls manual Sec. 9)
info	this card will display information about the next card that's swiped
	(Swirls manual Sec. 23)
M	this card will change the dancing style of the next card that's swiped to M
F	this card will change the dancing style of the next card that's swiped to F
MF	this card will change the dancing style of the next card that's swiped to MF
FM	this card will change the dancing style of the next card that's swiped to FM
E	this card will change the dancing style of the next card that's swiped to E
Basic	this card will change the program (level) of the next card that's swiped to Basic
	ditto for the other program levels
